1. Apologies for Absence

2. Matters Arising

Jo Dawson played her first match for Kingston B Team and was very successful.

BS spoke to Chris Stephens who informed her that if a member is affiliated during the season temporary affiliation numbers are given and then at the beginning of the next season new affiliation numbers are given.

Netballs must be pumped before games and before practice, we need a volunteer to do this. MD suggested that the club invest in an electric pump, but as we would need more than one it was felt that this would probably not be feasible.

Gill gave Kelly Captain's duties information.
